

## INSTRUCTIONS TO AUTHORS

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In zoological systematics we recommend the following itemised description of new taxa: type locality; holotype: sex, deposition, citation of identification labels; other material studied; description, distribution, etymology, differential diagnosis, remarks. (Abbreviations as gen. nov. or sp. nov. are used.) References in the text should be cited as: JACOBSON (1905), (MAJER 1993), RENDAHL & VESTERGREN (1941), BURAKOWSKI *et al.* (1985). All these references must be listed in the respective section in a form strictly consistent with previous issues of the journal (available online). Transliterations of Cyrillic should follow the British standard.

Examples:

ANTONÍN V. & NOORDELOOS M. E. 2010: *A monograph of marasmiod and collybioid fungi in Europe*. IHW-Verlag, Eching, 480 pp.

RENDAHL H. & VESTERGREN G. 1941: Notes on Colombian snakes. *Arkiv för Zoologi* **33A(1)**: 1–16.

Manuscripts written in poor English may be rejected. The AMM editorial board ensures only minor linguistic correction. Manuscripts should be written in standard fonts (Arial or Times New Roman), with the margins of all lines ranged left without using the tab key, paragraph indention or divided words. Use of the formatting tools is undesirable, with exception of italics for the scientific names and small capitals for names of cited authors. Artworks (e.g., figures, graphs, maps) should be submitted in tiff or jpeg format. Tables should be provided in a separate file, preferably as MS Word or Excel documents. Figure and table captions must be given in the end of manuscript. Authors may indicate the general location of the individual graphics (tables). Publication size of figures: 12.5×17 cm (full size), 12.5×<11 cm (half size). Resolution of figures: min. 600 dpi (bitmap), min. 300 dpi (greyscale, colour).
